

### **PASTOR'S MESSAGE**

The Apostle Paul addressed some of the greatest divisions of his day in his letter to the Galatians. The differences in his day split the entire population into different camps. The insiders and the outsiders were clearly defined, and Paul's task was to preach a unifying message of Jesus. Threatened by both groups Paul described the work of Jesus as being above the differences they used to arrange their society. Paul preached another way, the way of Jesus, to bring seemingly opposite groups of people together.



What are the great dividers of today? Republicans and Democrats, residents of Yorktown and Somers, white/Caucasian and people of color, LGBTQIA+, straight and church members and "outsiders"-there are all sorts of ways that we divide ourselves. We are going to get into all of this during our upcoming Bible study using the book of Galatians. Galatians is a short (only 5 pages long), deep, challenging and relevant message for us today. We will run two sessions of this study Tuesday evenings at 7:<mark>30 and</mark> Wednesdays at 1pm. Classes will start June 10th and run for 4 weeks.

Looking back, all I can say is "What a month it has been!" We completed our Lenten season and had our first in person, in sanctuary Easter celebration in two years. We hosted an awesome 2nd Annual Easter Egg hunt with a produce sale (that broke records) and helped clean up at the Battle of Yorktown. All of this is possible because we have the best volunteer helpers. You are making this church known as one that is outgoing, fun and welcomes all people. THANK YOU for helping make this our reputation. Coming up we have the Mother's Day Paint and Sip, Confirmation Sunday and we celebrate our graduates on June 12.

You've also noticed we are serving coffee and snacks once again after worship (cookies and bagels coming soon). I am a firm believer that the fellowship taking place in the Gathering Space is just as important to our lives as disciples as the worship that happens in the sanctuary. Therefore, we are stepping our coffee service up. Coming soon, real mugs, coffee directly from San Lucas Toliman and more. Thanks to several generous friends of the congregation, you will be enjoying fairly traded coffee in an enhanced atmosphere. These improvements will not only add to our fellowship time, they will keep lots of paper cups out of the landfill and cut down our costs over time.
