

Pastor's Message

Next week we will celebrate my 15th anniversary of ordination. "Ordination" is a fancy church word which refers to the actual ceremony in which someone is named, blessed, and tasked with the role of Pastor. Bishop Paul Egensteiner will be joining us and preaching during worship.

Afterwards we'll join together in a meal. Let me be clear, this is NOT about ME. It is a celebration of the work of the church to inspire people

to follow God's direction with their lives. Jesus called his disciples right from their boat, I received no direct demand that I leave behind my life and take on a new journey. The calling I received towards ministry involved lots of people, significant doubt, loads of conversation and tons of prayer. I can't "possess" this

calling because it wouldn't happen without all the people that encouraged me, challenged me, and accompanied me.

I must ask you, have you pointed out how God is moving through someone else. Maybe they don't see it. If so, you may be helping clarify God's calling in their lives. It is a communal process. In the process of ordination, this story is told and confirmed by others. God wants me to live out my faith as a pastor. God wants you to live out your faith also, maybe as a teacher, nurse, heavy equipment operator, an investment manager or homemaker. We all have work to do for the kingdom of God. Martin Luther called it the "priesthood of all believers" as he tried to point out that God is at work through all sorts of people.

So please come and enjoy this special day, worship with vigor, steep in the wisdom of Bishop Egensteiner, stir your soul with special music, share a meal-but above all things, see God moving through your life, God using your hands and God welcoming you onto the team of disciples.
