I'm into a new book and can't wait to share it with you. "Sailboat Church; Helping Your Church Rethink Its Mission and Practice" by Joan Grey. We are going to put a book club together in February to discuss this work. Using the metaphors of a sailboat vs a rowboat. Both can get from place to place, but one works with the Creator while the other relies on its own strength. There are sailboat churches and rowboat churches, I hope that this discussion can gut us wondering together whether we are working with the wind or against it.

Another reason I am excited...have you heard about our new tenant? The Exploratory Play Center of Yorktown, EPCY (rhymes with Pepsi), will be using our space to bring in loads of kids from Yorktown and the surrounding area to play and learn in *our* building. Moms and Dads will be hanging out in *our space* possibly wondering what kind of church is this? It could be awesome for everyone involved; I really think this relationship can be mutually beneficial. It is in our best interests to help EPCY be successful. I will be sharing their news and opportunities with you in hopes that their services not only support some of you, but we can share with others.
